Evergreen Hunter: No Points 2', 2'3"-2'6", 2'6"-2'9" Championship & Reserve

Modified Adult Equitation CHJA NEHC CHSA Open to adult amateur riders who, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at recognized shows in Adult Equitation classes, including CHJA Adult Medal classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. *For amateurs who have won six blue ribbons, they are eligible for Modified Adult if, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 3' or higher at more than three recognized horse shows within the past two show years. *Fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

Modified Adult Hunter: CHSA, CHJA NEHC C - 2'6" Adults eligible for Modified Adult Equitation.

Adult Amateur Hunter: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC B - 2'9"-3'

Adult Amateur Equitation: CHSA, CHJA, NEHC B - 2'9" - 3'

Junior Exhibitor English Pleasure: CHSA

Adult Exhibitor Pleasure: CHSA

Quarter Horse Hunter Under Saddle: CHSA NEHC C (NEHC not the championship class)

CHSA Open English Pleasure Open to members and non-members
NEHC Open Pleasure: Open to members and non-members NEHC C

Hunter Pleasure: CHSA, NEHC C

Children's Pleasure Pony: CHSA, NEHC C to be ridden by a Junior

Walk Trot Hunt Seat (Beginner) Pleasure: CHSA, NEHC C - Riders 10 and under, never shown at a canter or jump.

Walk Trot Hunt Seat Equitation: CHSA, CHJA, NEHC B - Same as W-T Pleasure

Hunt Seat Lead Rein: Riders under 7 CHSA, CHJA

Long Stirrup Equitation - CHSA - Riders 18 and over in first years of showing

Short Stirrup Equitation - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC B - Cross Rails - Riders riders under 12 as of 12/1/07. Have never shown fences over 18". Ineligible for any other classes except Pleasure and Pet Pony

Short Stirrup Hunter - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC C - same as SS Equitation

Short Stirrup Pleasure (no points)

Schooling Hunter - 2' No Points

Pre-Children's Hunter - CHJA, CHSA,* NEHC C- juniors eligible for Limit Eq over fences, as of December 1 of the current show year, showing horses or ponies. 2'. same rider/horse/pony may not enter into Children's Hunter Horse/Pony or Pony Hunter or any class where fences exceed 2'6". riders

Pre-Children's Equitation – CHSA CHJA Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of Dec. 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies, fence height 2'0". At the same show riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunter, any Medal Class over 2'0", or any class where fences exceed 2'6".

Children's Hunt Seat Equitation - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC B-2' sm /med ponies and 2'6" for large and horses -3'. May not cross enter into Junior Equitation

Open Hunt Seat Equitation Under 12 - CHJA, CHSA NEHC B, - Fences 2'

Open Hunt Seat Equitation 12-14 - CHSA, CHJA NEHC B- Fences not to exceed 3'

Open Hunt Seat Equitation 15-17 - CHSA, CHJA NEHC B- Fences not to exceed 3'6"

Children's Hunter Pony - CHSA, CHJA, NEHC C- Rider must be eligible for Intermediate Equitation. Small/Medium 2'; Large 2'6"

Children's Hunter Horse: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC B- 3'. Riders must be eligible for Intermed. Eq

Junior Equitation - CHSA, CHJA, - 3' Riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation.

Low Training Jumper - CHSA, CHJA –Fences 2'6"

Mod Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper – 2'6"-No points

Schooling Jumper – 3'0"-No Points

Knee High Jumper – fences 2' – 2'3". Open to any horse/pony/rider combination. No points.

Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper - CHSA, CHJA, NEHC C- Fences 3'3"

\$500 M & S Child/Adult Amateur Jumper Classic – Fences 3'3" – 3'6" Table II, Sec 2(a/b)

Junior/Amateur Jumper - CHJA, CHSA - Fences 3'6" - 4'

CT Open Jumper - CHJA, CHSA NEHC B - Fences 3'6"-3'9"

M & S Hunter Classics – The last round in the division counts as the first classic round. The numerical score of that round will be combined with that of the Classic round. M & S will award bonus points for children's and adult hunter champion and Reserve.

M & S Adult Hunter Classic 3' M & S will award bonus points for children's and adult hunter champion and Reserve. M & S Children's Hunter Horse/Pony Classic 3' horses 2'6" large 2' med/sm

Bit o' Straw Hunter Classic- Open to Jr. or Amateur riders.

No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into M & S children's or adult Hunter classic or into any USEF rated hunter division. 2'6"

Medal Classes:

CHJA Medals: A two phase class with each phase worth 50%. First fences round, then at least 6 competitors (if available) to return for work on the flat. Exhibitors MUST be members of the respective medal organization in order to compete in the medal class.

CHJA Children's Medal: Open to Junior members of the CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter and who have not shown over a course at a Recognized show where fences exceeded 3'0". If you have ever qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Finals including CHJA you are not eligible for the Children's Medal.

CHJA Junior Medal: Fences not to exceed 3'. Optional tests 1-19

CHJA Adult Medal: Fences not to exceed 3' Optional tests 1-19

CHJA Pony Medal: Fences 2' (sm); 2'3" (med) and 2'9" (large)

M & S Adult Hunter Classic 3'

M & S Adult Medal 3'

M & S Children's Hunter Horse/Pony Classic 3' horses 2'6" large 2' med/sm

M & S Children's Medal Horse/Pony 3' horses 2'6" large 2' med/sm

M & S Hunter Classics – 3rd round of division counts as 1st classic round. The numerical score of that round will be combined with that of the Classic round. M & S Medals – minimum 8 fences w/a combination and two changes of direction. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required.

M & S Central Equine Junior Medal: 3'6"

NEHC Adult Medal: 3'

CHSA medals will be held with the third jumping class of their division.

Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current CHJA/CHSA/NEHC rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In order to accrue points for these affiliated organizations exhibitors and /or their horses must be members. Points will count immediately upon receipt of application and dues at the member show – or the postmark if the application is mailed.
2. The membership forms for CHSA/CHJA/NEHC will be available along with the Specifications for all CHJA/CHSA/NEHC recognized classes, at the secretary's office
3. Prize money not applied to the exhibitor's balance can be picked up at secretary's stand.
4. Warm-ups will be allowed before each hunter and equitation jumping division for horses/ponies in that division. Warm-up fees are \$15 per horse per warm-up.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted. Management also reserves the right to vary the officials, including the judges, if necessary, and to change the courses at their discretion.
6. Entries are due by 5 p.m. the night before the show. Any entry after this is considered a post entry and will be charged a \$15 post entry fee.
7. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
8. All entries must be signed by the Owner/Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to picking up your show number.
9. Exhibitors must be in proper attire for all classes.
10. A processing fee of \$25 shall be charged for each non negotiable check.
11. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
12. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the committee, but MVHC, Inc., CHJA /CHSA/NEHC will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold MVHC, Inc., NEHC, CHJA, and CHSA as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
13. All medal and stake and classic classes are \$35.00. M&S Child/Adult Jumper Classic is \$50. All other classes are \$25 Warm ups \$15
14. There will be a \$10 office fee added to each entry.
15. A copy of the CHSA/CHJA/NEHC/ Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chsonline, www.chja.net., and www.nehc.com,www.hitsshows.com To show in CHJA,NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members.
16. In order to compete in stakes or classics, exhibitor must enter and compete in at least one over fences class in the same division.
