Low Evergreen Hunter: No Points Fences 2' 6" Championship & Reserve
Adequan Hunter a horse of any age and is not restricted by previous showing in any division Fences not to exceed 3'5". open to juniors, amateurs, and professionals. Championship & Reserve
Modified Adult Equitation CHJA NEHC CHSA Open to adult amateur riders who, as of Dec. 1 of the current show year, have not won six blue ribbons at recognized shows in Adult Equitation classes, including CHJA Adult Medal classes, but excluding Modified Adult Classes. *Fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders in this division cannot show in any other recognized classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6". For amateurs who have won 6 blue ribbons, they are eligible for Mod Adult if, as of Dec 1st of the current show year, if they have not show in classes 3' or higher at more than 3 USEF or CHJA shows in the past 2 show years.
Modified Adult Hunter: CHSA, CHJA, NEHC-2'6" Adults eligible for Modified Adult Equitation.
Adult Amateur Hunter: CHJA, CHSA, NEHC, M & S- 2'9"-3'
Adult Amateur Equitation: CHSA, CHJA,NEHC - 2'9" - 3'
Junior Exhibitor English Pleasure: CHSA
Adult Exhibitor English Pleasure: CHSA
Color Breed Pleasure: CHSA
Quarter Horse Hunter under Saddle: CHSA, NEHC

Short Stirrup Hunter - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC- same as SS Equitation

Long Stirrup Equitation - CHSA – Riders 18 and over in first years of showing

CHJA Children's Medal: Fences 2'6" Junior members who are eligible for Children's Hunter and have not jumped over 3' at recognized show including CHJA Junior Medal Finals. riders are excluded if they have ever qualified or shown in any 3' medal finals. Optional tests - 1-8
CHJA Junior Medal: Fences not to exceed 3'. Optional tests 1-19
CHJA Adult Medal: Fences not to exceed 3' Optional tests 1-19
CHJA Pony Medal: Fences 2' (small); 2'3" (med) and 2'9" (large)

Pre-Children's Hunter - CHJA, CHSA,NEHC - Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of Dec. 1 of the current show year. Horses or ponies - height 2'0". At the same show, horse/rider and pony/rider combinations may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse or Children's Hunter Pony, Pony Hunters or any class where fences exceed 2'6".
Pre-Children's Equitation –CHJA, CHSA Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of Dec. 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies, fence height 2'0". At the same show riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunter, any Medal Class over 2'0", or any class where fences exceed 2'6".
Children's Hunt Seat Equitation - CHJA, CHSA, NEHC 2'6". May not cross enter into Junior Equitation must be eligible for Children's Hunters, never shown over 3' and never shown in the CHJA Children's Hunters and never shown in the CHJA Junior Medal Finals.
Walk Trot Hunt Seat (Beginner) Pleasure: CHSA,NEHC - Riders 10 and under, never shown at a canter or jumped
Walk Trot Hunt Seat Equitation: CHSA, CHJA, NEHC Same as W-T Pleasure
Children's Hunter Horse: CHJA, CHSA NEHC - 3'.
Children's Hunter Ponies - CHJA, CHSA NEHC (2' s/m & 2'6" large)
Junior Equitation - CHSA, CHJA - 3' Riders may not cross enter into children's equitation
Low Training Jumper - CHSA, CHJA - Fences 2'6"-3'
Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper - CHSA, CHJA NEHC - Fences 2'9"-3'6"
CT Open Jumper - CHSA, CHJA Fences 3'6"-3'9"
M & S Hunter Classics – The numerical score of the 1st round will be combined with that of the 2nd round. M & S will award bonus points for children's and adult hunter Champion and Reserve.
M & S Adult Hunter Classic 3' M & S will award bonus points for children's and adult hunter.
M & S Children's Hunter Horse/Pony Classic 3' horses 2'6" large 2' sm/med
Bit O'Straw Hunter Classic- Open to Jr. or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into M & S children's or adult Hunter classic or into any USEF rated hunter division. 2'6"
Adequan Hunter Classic - Open to horses of any age and is not restricted by previous showing in any division. Fences 3'5" Open to juniors, amateurs, and professionals.
M & S Adult Medal 3' Open to Adult and Amateur Riders. The rider must be a member in order for points to count
M & S Children's Medal Horse/Pony 3' horses 2'6" large 2' med/sm Open to Junior Riders on horses who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3"
M & S Child/Adult Jumper Classic fences 3'3"
NEHC Adult Medal: fences no to exceed 3'open to adult /amateur members
NEHC Junior Medal: fences not to exceed 3'3" open to junior members

Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current CHJA/CHSA /NEHC /M&S rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
 2. Prize money not applied to the exhibitor's balance can be picked up at secretary's stand.
 3. Warm-ups will be allowed before each hunter and equitation jumping division for horses/ponies in that division. Warm-up fees are \$15 per horse per warm-up.
 4. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted. Management also reserves the right to vary the officials, including the judges, if necessary, and to change the courses at their discretion.
 5. Entries are due by 5 p.m. the night before the show. Any entry after this is considered a post entry and will be charged a \$15 post entry fee.
 6. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
 7. All entries must be signed by the Owner/Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to picking up your show number.
 8. Exhibitors must be in proper attire for all classes.
 9. A processing fee of \$25 shall be charged for each non negotiable check.
 10. All dogs must be leashed at all times.
 11. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the committee, but MVHC, Inc., CHJA /CHSA /NEHC /M&S will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold MVHC, Inc., CHJA, NEHC, CHSA, and M&S as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision is final.
 12. All Medal, Stake Classes, and Classics are \$30.00, except the \$500 M&S Child Adult Jumper Classic which is \$50. All other classes are \$25.
 13. To be eligible to show in a Stake or Classic, exhibitors must enter and show in one other class in that division. Stake classes will pay out the following monies: 1st \$20, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10, 4th \$5. \$100 M&S Hunter Classics will pay the following monies: 1st \$40, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th \$10. \$500 M&S Jumper Classics will pay the following monies: 1st \$150, 2nd \$130, 3rd \$90, 4th \$60, 5th \$40, 6th \$30.
 14. There will be a \$10 office fee added to each entry.
 15. The membership forms for CHSA /CHJA / NEHC /M&S will be available along with the Specifications for all CHJA/CHSA/ NEHC/ M&S recognized classes, at the secretary's office
 16. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA.
